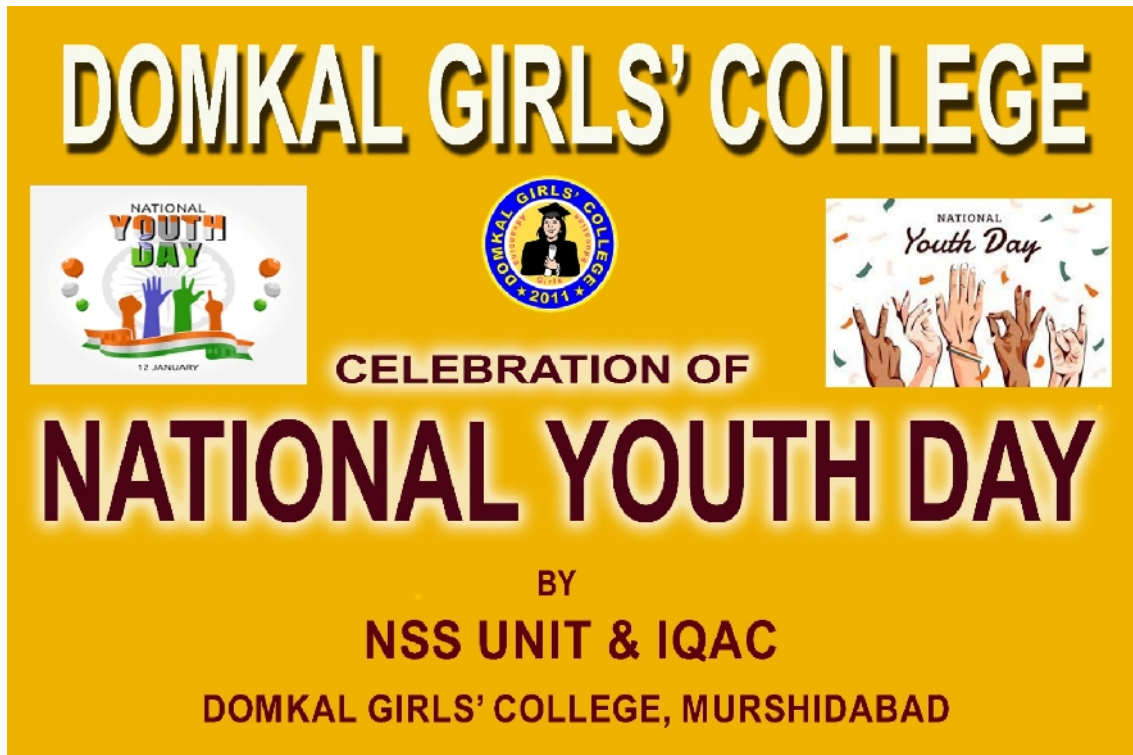

The National youth Day was celebrated in collaboration with IQAC of Domkal Girls' College and NSS unit.

National Youth Day, also known as **Swami Vivekananda Birthday** or **Yuva Diwas**, is celebrated with joy and enthusiasm in India every year on January 12. This celebration honours the birthday of **Swami Vivekananda** who played a crucial role in shaping modern India. The **Government of India** officially declared it as **National Youth Day in 1984**, and since 1985, it has been celebrated across the country.

The celebration holds great significance as it aims to share the thoughts and principles of Swami Vivekananda among the youth of India. It serves as a

means to awaken the enduring energy of the youth and encourage their significant efforts towards the development of the country.

The history of National Youth Day can be traced back to the government's decision to observe it annually on Swami Vivekananda's birthday, aiming to inspire the country's youth with his philosophy and ideals. The goal is to motivate young people to contribute to the betterment of the nation by embracing Swami Vivekananda's way of life and ideas. In 1984, the Indian Government announced that January 12, the birthday of Swami Vivekananda, would be celebrated as **National Youth Day**. Since then, people all over the country have observed this day. This celebration serves as a positive way to energise the youth and promote the development of the country.

About Swami Vivekananda

Swami Vivekananda's Pre-monastic name was Narendra Nath Dutta. He was born on **12 January 1863** in Kolkata (previously Calcutta) and died on **4 July 1902**. His father's name was Vishwanath Dutta and his mother's name was Bhuvaneshwari Devi. He belonged to a well-off family. His father died suddenly at a young age and this broke the financial backbone of his family and pushed him into poverty. Despite being a good student, he failed to get a job for a very long time. He used to ask for a job from door to door but he didn't get a job and so he became an atheist. One of his English professors introduced him with the name 'Shri Ramkrishna Paramhansa' and in 1881, he met with Shri Ramakrishna Paramhansa at Dakshineswar's Kali temple and became a disciple of Saint Ramakrishna Paramhansa. He introduced the Indian philosophies of Vedanta and Yoga to the Western World. He was extremely patriotic toward India and is considered a hero for his contributions to the philosophies of his country. He also drew attention to the widespread poverty in India and for the development of the country, the poverty issues should be taken seriously. He is best known for his speech at the Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago in 1893 when he began his speech by saying "Sisters and brothers of America....." and he introduced India's culture, its importance, Hinduism, etc.
