Self-Help through Self-rule

Macrocosmic change is not possible without a retrospective microcosmic transformation of the self. The Pendulum movement of life oscillates with the lived experiences. This was the consequential trajectory of the experience that the Mahatma underwent. From a mediocre student to being the father of the nation is a testament to the power of a common man to transform himself. The solidification of Mahatma Gandhi's perception of reality and the normative standards that he set out determined the trajectory of action that he undertook. His perception of truth was not valueneutral but rather characterized by a deep normative standard which was morally and ethically justified. His existential outlook didn't deal with the absurd but it deals with the belief in the possibility of non-violent progress of mankind which is sustainable and in tune with the tenets of nature. He belonged to that group of thinkers which had Henry David Thoreau, and Leo Tolstoy in its rank. He was not a Bismarck. He was not a military figure but he was a philosopher.
