Seminar Proceedings:

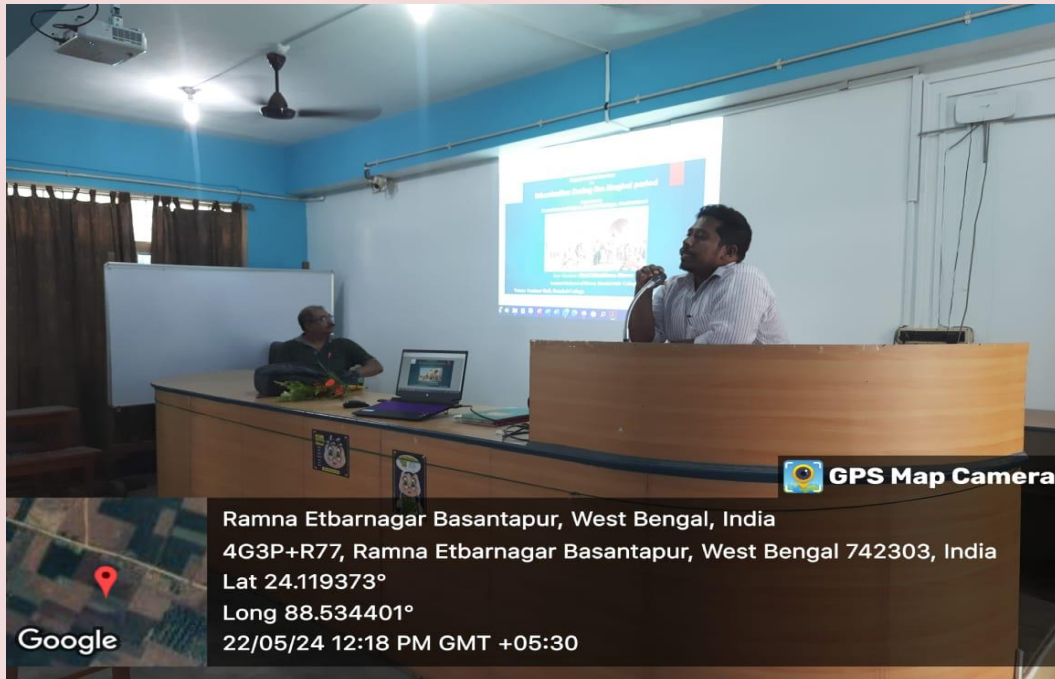

Lecture on Urbanization during the Mughal Period:

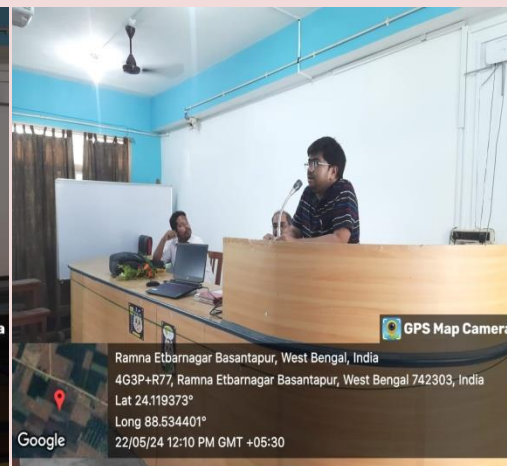
