


# DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE

#### **Observations:**

- 1. The number of one student who did not qualify the semester exam (1 out of 4 students i.e. 25%).
- 2. Total students of the department 3 students are qualified for the examination, those were advanced learners. (3 of 4 i.e. 75%).
- 3. Miss Sairina Khatun got 66.67% which was the highest percentage of that semester of the department.


#### Recommendation:

- 1. Students who did not pass should be placed in remedial classes right away.

#### Recommendation:


- 3. In order for moderate learners to move to the advanced level, work needs to be done with them.

## Overall Observations for 2018-19:

- In the semester 1 batch have 3 students, who secured above 60% marks but in the semester 2 there have 1 student secured above 60% marks.
- There are a considerable 1 learner failed to the 1<sup>st</sup> semester exam, but in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester all students are passed, no one failed in that examination.

## Recommendations for 2018-19:

- The students who did not qualify should immediately be put in remedial programmes.
- Work should be done with the moderate learners so that they may upgrade themselves to the advanced level.
- The advanced learners should be encouraged to maintain their levels and should be specially encouraged to take up masters in the future
