


Session wise Result analysis of Geography department: 1st semester (2019-2020):



Observations:


- 1. The number of two (2) student who did not qualify the semester exam (1 out of 5 students i.e. 40%).
- 2. Total students of the department 3 students are qualified for the examination, those were moderate learners. (3 of 5 i.e. 60%).
- 3. Miss Mst Sahina Khatun & Miss Murshida Khatun jointly ranked 1st position of the department in that examination with securing 58.67% marks.

Recommendation:

- 1. Students who did not pass should be placed in remedial classes right away.
- 2. In order for moderate learners to move to the advanced level, work needs to be done with them.



- 3. The students who placed first were also urged to keep up their grades, and they ought to receive extra encouragement to pursue master's degrees in the future.
- 4. 2nd semester (2019-2020):



Observations:

- 1. Total students of the department (4) are qualified for the examination, those were advanced learners, because of all were secured above 60% marks secured in that examination (4 of 4 i.e. 100%).
- 2. Miss Mst Sahina Khatun got 89.33% which was the highest percentage of that semester of the department.


Recommendation:

- 2. Miss Sairina Khatun got 76% which was the highest percentage of that semester of the department.


Recommendation:

Observations:


