


Session wise Result analysis of Geography department: 1st semester (2020-2021):




Observations:

2nd semester (2020-2021):




Observations:

Observations:



Result analysis of 4th semester (2020-2021)




Observations:

5th semester (2020-2021):




Observations:

6th semester (2020-2021):




Observations:
