


## 1ST SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2020-2021



# **OBSERVATIONS (SEM-1, 2020-2021)**

#### 1. Overall Performance:

■ The qualification rate is very high, with 54 out of 54 students qualified.

#### 2. Advance Learners:

■ Almost all students (94.4%) fall into the advance learner category.

#### 3. Moderate Learners:

Only one student (1.9%) falls into the moderate learner category.

#### 4. Slow Learners:

Encourage continued academic excellence and provide opportunities for further enrichment.


#### ✓ For Moderate Learners and Slow Learners:

# RECOMMENDATIONS (SEM-2, 2020-2021)


For Advance Learners:

# 5TH SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2020-2021




## 5<sup>TH</sup> SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2020-2021

- High Qualification Rate: A significant majority of students (96.3%) qualified, which indicates a high overall performance level in this cohort.
- All Qualified Students as Advanced Learners: All students who qualified were categorized as advanced learners, scoring above 60%. This suggests that the qualifying students performed exceptionally well.
- Absence of Moderate and Slow Learners: There were no students in the moderate learner (45% to below 60%) or slow learner (30% to below 45%) categories, indicating a clear distinction between high performers and those who did not qualify.
- Small Percentage of Non-Qualified Students: Only 2 students did not qualify, which is a relatively low number (3.7%). These students might need additional support or interventions to meet the required standards.

# RECOMMENDATIONS FOR (5<sup>TH</sup> SEM, 2020-21)

- Feedback from Students: Gather feedback from students regarding the teaching methods and course content to understand what works best for them.

- There are no students in these categories.


# RECOMMENDATIONS FOR (6<sup>TH</sup> SEM, 2020-21)

### **OVERALL OBSERVATIONS FOR 2020-2021**
