1ST SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2022-2023



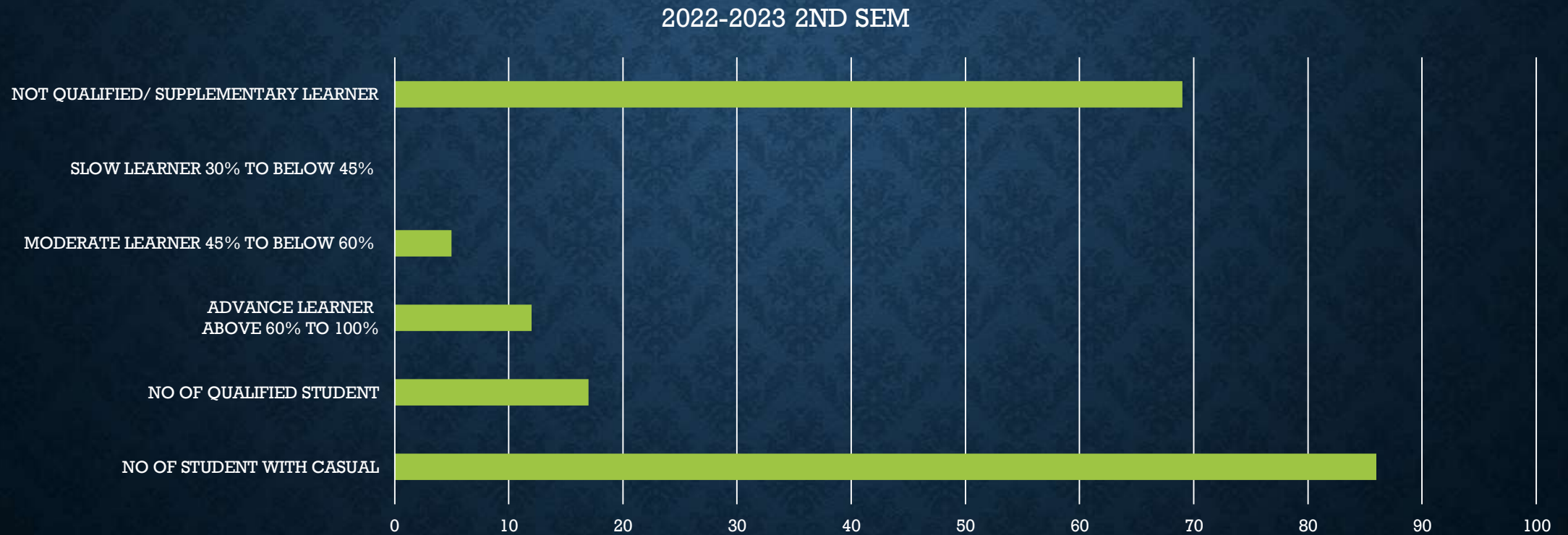
OBSERVATIONS (SEM-1, 2022-2023)

- **Qualified Student Percentage:** Approximately 54.9% of the students qualified in the 1st Semester.

2ND SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2022-2023



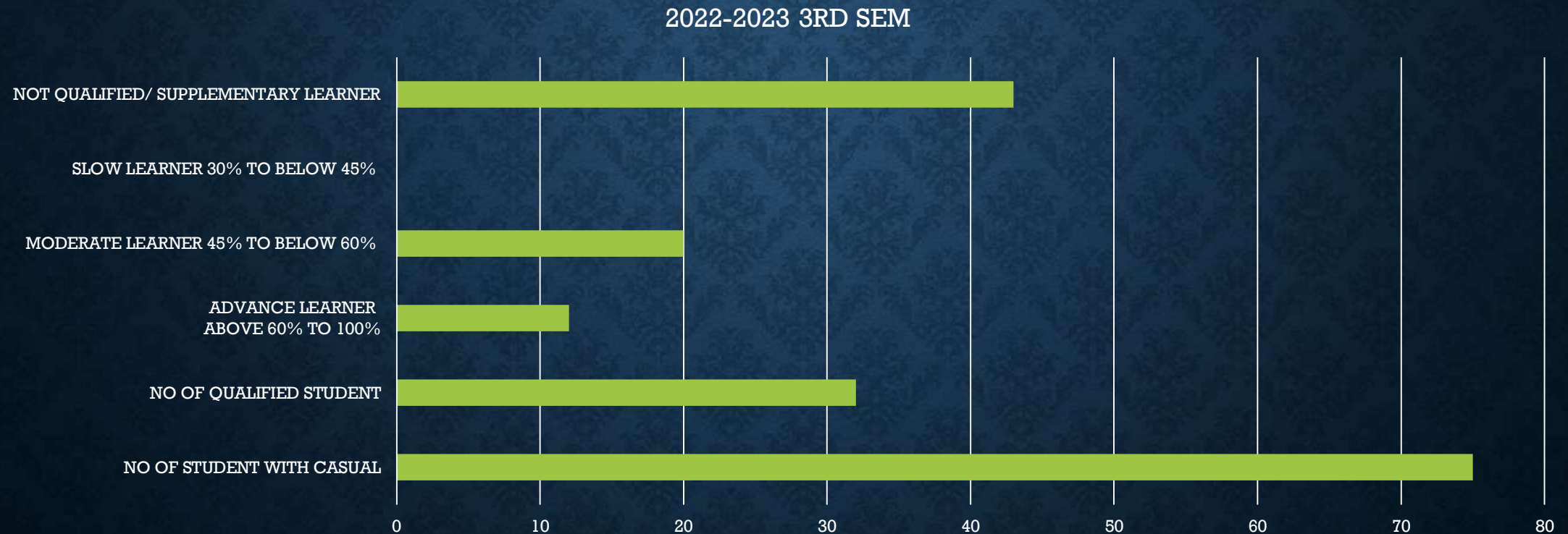
OBSERVATIONS (SEM-2, 2022-2023)

4TH SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2022-2023



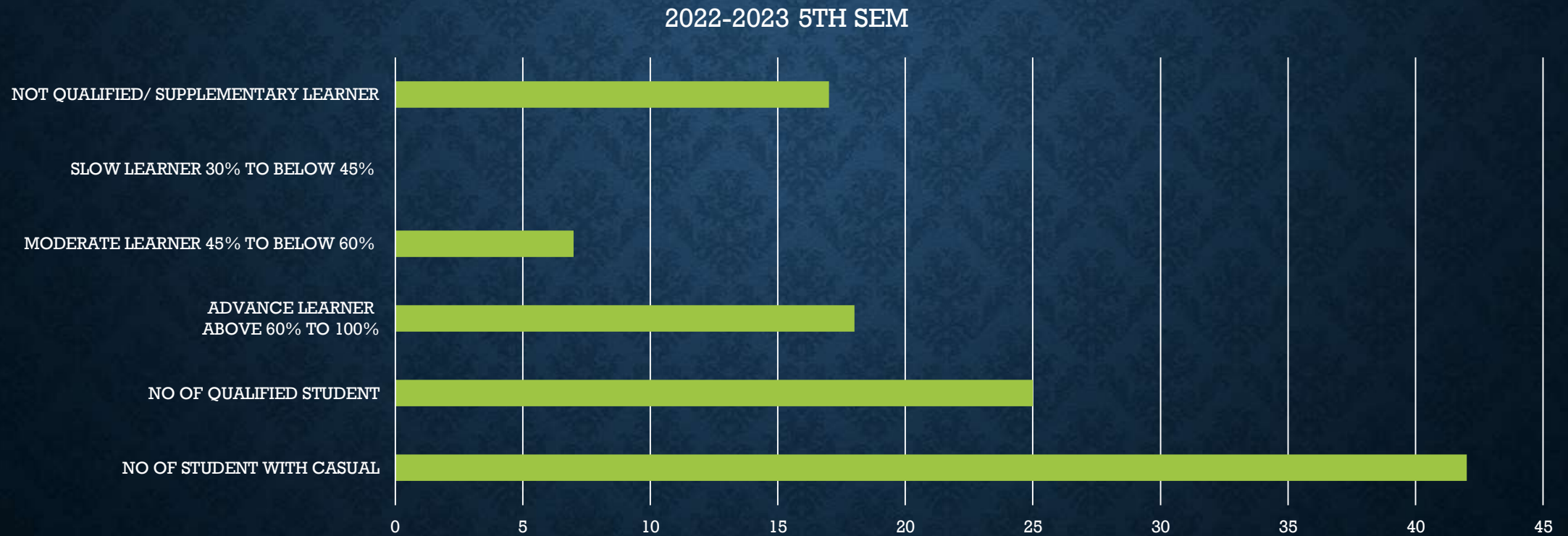
OBSERVATIONS (4TH SEM, 2022-2023)

5TH SEM RESULT ANALYSIS OF 2022-2023



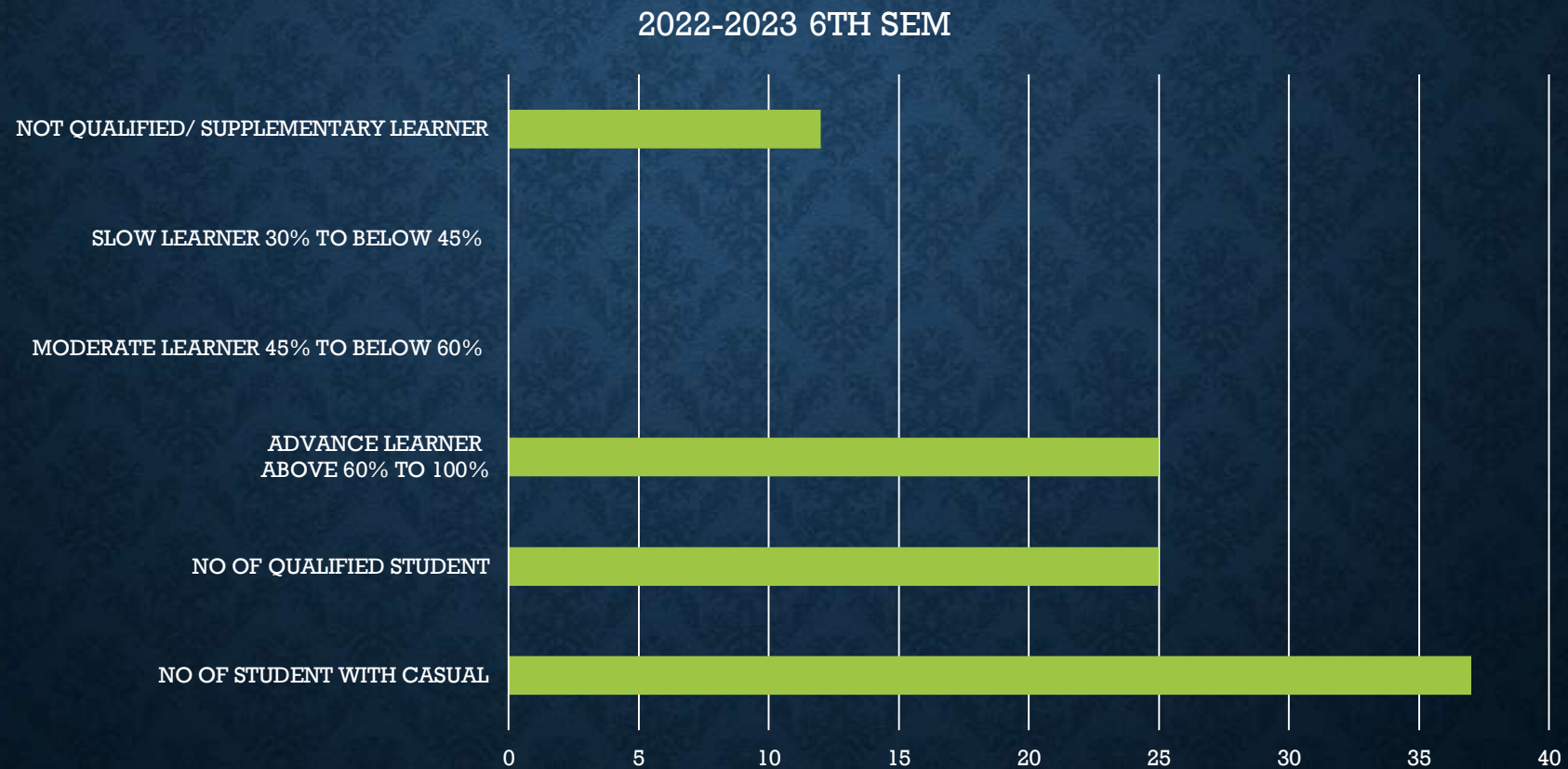
OBSERVATION (5TH SEM, 2022-2023)

OBSERVATION (6TH SEM 2022-2023)

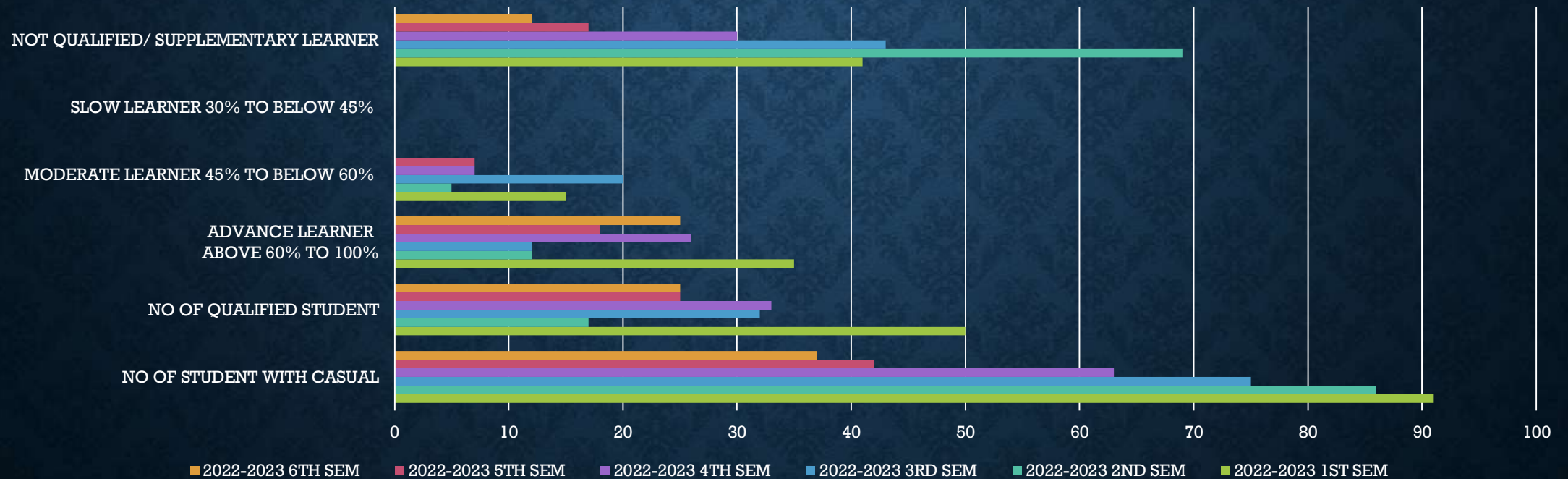
- **Qualified Student Percentage:** Approximately 67.6% of the students qualified in the 6th Semester.

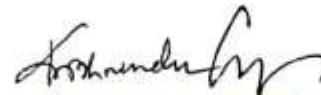
